## CREDITS AND STUDY LOAD

HAN uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).

Credits are based on study load:

- 1 ECTS credit = 28 hours of study

How many credits do you obtain in 1 semester?

- 30 ECTS credits = 840 hours of study
